

3.3 MARPOL Reports

Reporting requirements under Article 17 of Directive 2002/59/EC (Reporting of incidents and accidents at sea) applying in addition to MARPOL (Article 8 and Protocol I to that Convention) as implemented by the national legislation of EU and EEA member states, apply to all ships of 300 gigatonnes or more with the exception of:

- fishing vessels;
- traditional ships;
- recreational craft having a length of less than 45 metres;
and
- ships carrying less than 5 000 tonnes bunker fuel.

MARPOL reports can be sent via every coastal radio station. The responsible organisations for MARPOL reports are listed below. The organisations co-ordinate the necessary measures for assistance and rescue, when incidents occur and cargo (especially dangerous or polluting goods) is damaged, or when the sea is, or may be, polluted.
